Message from Our Leadership

Dear Friends,

We are pleased to share our 2020 Annual Report with you, covering activities from July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.

Here you will find a conventional representation of our somewhat unconventional year. We began the year with our fifth and most well-attended Margaret Metzger Fellowship evening. Five inspiring Brookline educators read their thoughtful and heartfelt essays about their lives in the classroom and with their students. We finished out the fall by awarding 17 Idea Lab grants across the District to support project-based learning.

Of course, our year was interrupted by the global pandemic, just as everyone else's was, but the generosity and dedication of our many supporters allowed our Spring 2020 grant cycle to proceed as usual. Our five amazing Team Brookline runners raised money and logged miles and despite the event cancellation, ran a virtual Marathon this Fall. Our beloved Trivia Bee, our only fundraising event of the year, also fell victim to the pandemic. Thanks to our incredible event sponsors and trivia-loving friends, who donated their tickets' cost, it wasn't a total loss for the organization. Additionally, another very generous gift from Denise Jefferson Casper and Marc N. Casper allowed us to fund grants for an additional 23 Special Education teachers in grades K-8. We are so thankful for all of this support during such a difficult time.

This spring, we moved our Board and committee meetings onto Zoom and continued our work. We were able to award 16 Teacher Grants and 16 Collaborative Grants for 2020-21. Sadly, we were not able to hold our Celebrating Teachers event in May, or honor educators with Caverly Awards this year. Those omissions and changes were disappointing, as they comprise an important part of our mission of honoring the excellence in Brookline education. Despite the rocky spring and thanks to our very generous and devoted donors, we finished the school year strong. Over 450 families participated in our Honor-a-Teacher fundraising campaign. So, in that way, Brookline teachers were still celebrated in a meaningful way.

We know that this school year will be different and challenging, as never before. We remain committed to supporting Brookline's amazing, hard-working, and dedicated educators. We are grateful to you, our donors, for your ongoing support.

We do encourage you to read through this Annual Report and look through our website to learn more about all of the creative and innovative ways in which Brookline teachers are pushing themselves to be better for their – and our -- students.

Each year, the BEF awards grants to Brookline teachers, staff, and administrators from preschool through grade 12. 

FY2020 - By the Numbers

BEF Grant committees selected **62 grants to fund for FY 2020**. Thanks to our generous supporters, **we were able to fund 15 more grants** than the prior year and impact many more teachers and students.



"Last year, eight BHS Math teachers participated in the DEEP/SRI Anti-Racism seminar through a BEF grant. Fueled by the inspiration, shared passion, and tools gained in the seminar, they planned and led math department meetings on **Culturally Responsive Teaching**, fostered ongoing discussions with colleagues on race and racism in our classrooms, and encouraged the BHS Math department to commit to a summer read/watch/listen on anti-racism in education. After the murder of George Floyd in the spring, the team created materials for students of all races to help them process the pain, reflect on the legacy of injustice, and find hope to move forward in the fight against racism."



The BEF would like to thank board member Karyn Wang for her leadership and support of this event.




